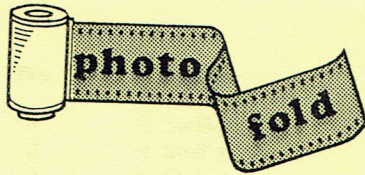

The Billericay Arts Association was set up in April 1979 as a registered charity to run The Fold as a community arts centre. A team of about 50 volunteers look after the premises and administration, assist with events or serve refreshments.

We run classes, organise a programme of drama, film, music, lectures, and exhibitions covering a wide range of arts related activities. In the past we have played host to Jill Freud Company, Frank Delaney, Alberni Quartet, Chris Barber, and many many more. The Fold also provides a meeting place for other groups, like Photofold, in the town.

Activities have increased to such an extent that the Association is negotiating with the Basildon Council for a new home at 108 High Street. This is a Grade II listed building which would be developed in three phases.
