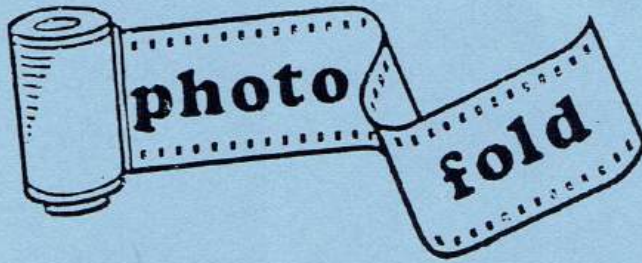
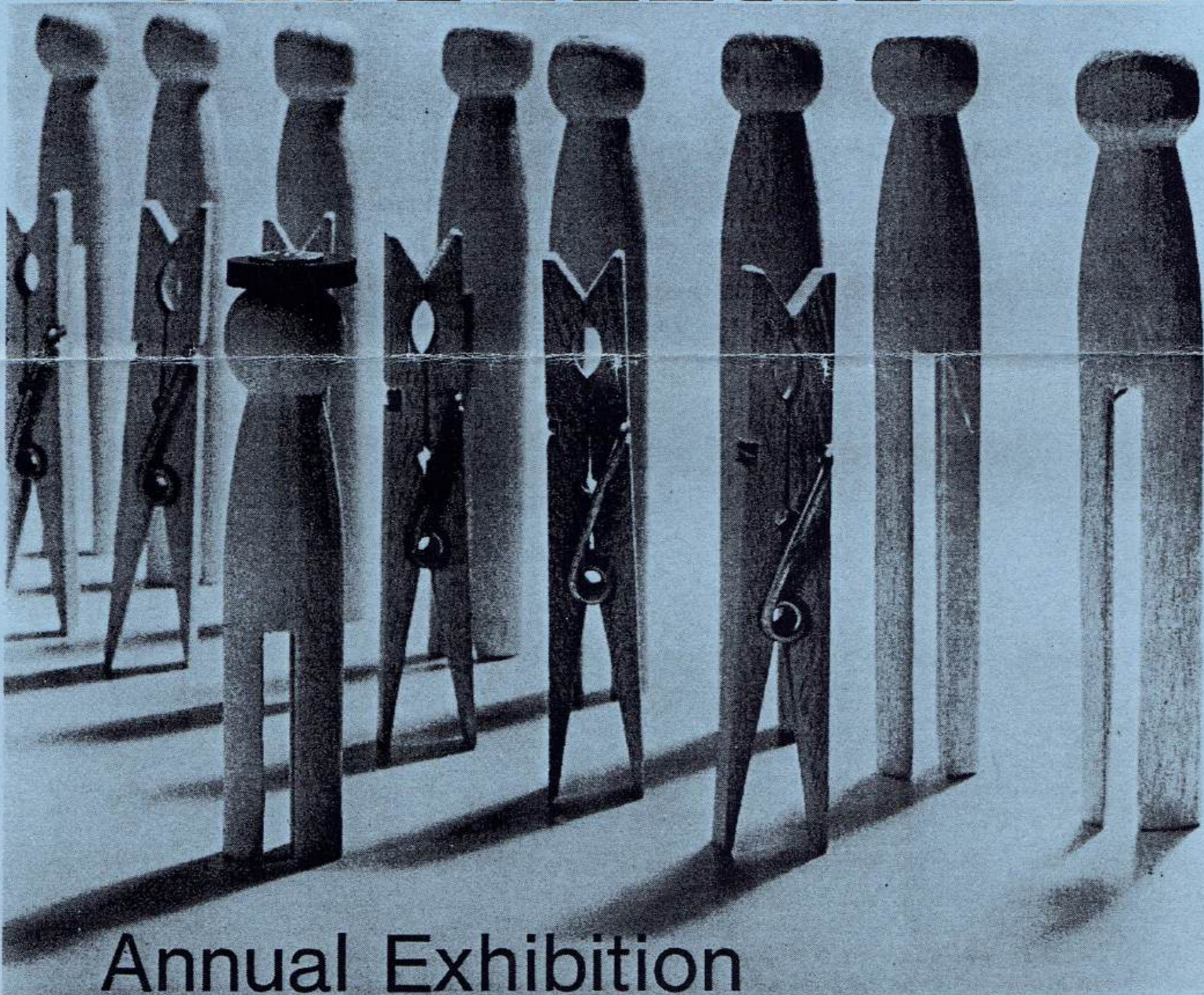

Billericay Arts Association is a registered charity, formed in 1979 to promote the arts in the Town. We have bought professional entertainers such as Paco Pena, Chris Barber, George Melly, Jill Read, The Gabrieli Quartet and the Red Swift Theatre Co. Our income stems from hiring our building, class fees for the leisure classes in art, pottery, drama, crochet and sculpture, subscriptions from our members and many donations from local people and groups. We are, we believe, the only Community Arts Centre in the U.K. which is run entirely by voluntary staff.
